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


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- Mr. Sommer shared how the newsletter is another tool meant to bridge the gap between school and home. He gathered ideas as to what would be beneficial and what support we provide families.

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
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- Our intervention coordinator and ELD TA shared what they are doing with the EL students and how they are using ELLevation and data chats to develop student ownership and provide specific feedback.
